Nano Nagle Network works with young people who are disengaged from mainstream education with the aim of re-engaging them in creative, meaningful and intentional learning. Our schools work with young people through a trauma informed approach respectful to the educational needs of each learner.

The Role:

- We are seeking an exceptional individual for our Flexible Learning Centres in Victoria, to manage the STEP-UP2U Project, a social-education-inclusion project that will provide a range of well-constructed activities that address the drivers of anti-social and criminal behaviour for high-risk young people.
- This position will complete planning, implementation, delivery and review/acquittal for the project, commencing May 2022 with a completion date of 30 April 2024.
- This role will work unconventional hours with the successful candidate being employed on a full-time basis working Monday to Thursday, 10am to 6pm with the fifth day of each week worked flexibly over Fridays and an 'on call' arrangement at weekends.
The program will be run in the afternoons on weekdays through to 8pm and then weekends during the day. The Project Manager will need to work flexibly in order to support staff outside of standard business hours.
- You will be employed on an ongoing basis, commencing ASAP and will be employed under the Victorian Catholic Education Multi Enterprise Agreement 2018.
- The role is based in Carlton, with travel to the school site in North Melbourne.
