

Change of Onsite Learning for Grade 7/8 Pulana (Friday 16th, Monday 19th & Tuesday 20th June)

Dear guardians and students of Grade 7/8 pulana

It has been brought to my attention that many students from **Grade 7/8 pulana** are not consistently following the four principles of our school (Participation, Honesty, Safe & Legal and Respect).

It has been decided that for tomorrow (Friday 16 June, Monday 19 June and Tuesday 20 June) all students of **pulana** will be undertaking offsite learning (no onsite learning for pulana students). During this time Caro (teacher), Ryan (Program Director – Wellbeing) and/or Sam (Youth Worker) will organise an outreach visit for all students in **pulana**. Caro and Sam will be in contact to organise a visit during this period.

During the visit, school staff will work with the young person and family members to revisit the four principles that all students and staff follow.

I apologise the inconvenience to our pulana families; however, I believe a reset is needed for the entire class in order for them to successfully move forward with their education at St Francis Flexible Learning Centre.

All students of **pulana** will be welcome back onsite on **Wednesday 21 June**.
